By Car

West Herts Crematorium is situated in High Elms Lane which is a small turning off the A405 (St Albans Road). The Crematorium is sign posted both sides of the dual carriage way. The nearest motorway junctions are Junction 6 on the M1 and Junction 21a on the M25. Follow the sign posts for the A405 Watford.

Access for visitors

On turning into High Elms Lane the Crematorium gates are on the right opposite the school.

On entering the Crematorium site the car parks are clearly signposted. There are car parking spaces for 125 cars. There are designated car parking spaces for the disabled and these are clearly marked. There are also signposts to these spaces. The car parks are managed during busy periods by auxiliary staff with two way radios enabling them to manage the various car parks efficiently. There is separate parking available for hearses and fimousines near to the Flower Terrace. Family are led to these cars after viewing their floral tributes.

By Rail

The nearest main train station to the Crematorium is Watford Junction. From there you can take a taxi from outside or you can take the bus no 321 St Albans bound and ask for St Michaels School. This bus stop is on the main road the A405 and is just two minutes walk from the main gate.

By Bus

The Crematorium is situated half way between Watford and St Albans. The bus service the 321 stops on the A405 both sides. There is a bus stop for this service outside Watford Junction which is the nearest main line train station to us. This bus also travels through to St Albans. The other bus service that also stops on the A405 is the Green Line bus the 724.
